## Parker invoices to Ann Walker

West Yorkshire Archives CN/99/2 A series of invoices covering the period 1838 to 1842.

Robert Parker (1798 – 1856) was a Halifax solicitor employed by both Ann Walker and Anne Lister. He was godson but not related to Robert Parker who was the solicitor associated with The Coiners. He practised at 6, The Square which was between the Piece Hall and Woolshops. Ann owned a lot of property in the area. Parker was in partnership with Thomas Adam for much of his professional life. 





#### Evan Charles Sutherland Walker. Analysis of properties, values and provenance.

This appears to be a set of accounts for Evan Charles Sutherland Walker of around 1865. Parts are difficult to read, especially names. Rents are to the nearest £. Has to be after 1863 as Hunger Hills & Ings Head sold in that year. [CN:95/5]

The journal has ES against several entries when the rent is shown in John Walker's column – presumably no longer entailed. Similarly for AW. However, a number of these properties appear to have belonged to Ann as their rental appears in Sam Washington's accounts.

Many properties itemised in the 1835 agreement can be identified and are highlighted if Elizabeth's or highlighted if Ann's. A few properties couldn't be identified. Approximate rental value of 1835 agreement would be around £1600 per annum. A few properties possibly increased significantly in value-fields becoming productive stone quarries. Rental from Oakview Mills, sold before this set of accounts, could have been in the order £200 to £300.
